Discover loft living at 517 Sandalwood

CAPE MAY BEACH – "This is like a Tribeca-SOHO loft apartment by the bay," said Jersey Cape Realty sales associate Heijung Park Colameco.

Enter the first floor and find unique living space with sliding pocket doors at each bedroom and into the tiled full bathroom. A laundry room leads to the attached, heated two-car garage. But more importantly, an industrial grade metal staircase takes you to the main feature – the second floor loft living area.

"This is a one of a kind house," Colameco said.

The living area displays all the features one finds in a loft in Manhattan, including red brick walls and exposed heating ducts. The owners also constructed tables using galvanized pipe as framework, and there are similar lighting fixtures over a long dining table that seats 12 or 15 with no problem. The southwest corner of the 2nd floor has nearly floor to ceiling windows – windows and light are a strong characteristic of this one of a kind home.

The chef's kitchen features a top of the line BCS stainless steel stove and granite countertops.

"There is a cute screened in porch off the kitchen," Colameco said.

The third level features a monstrosity large master bedroom with a bath containing a shower large enough in which to park a sub-compact car.

From the third floor there is access to a rooftop deck with panoramic views of the Cape May Beach area and good views of the Delaware Bay.

"This is not a Stone Harbor house," Colameco said. "This is not a cookie cutter house. This is something very unique, but very functional."

Constructed in 2004 by local Mike Lating Builder, Colameco said the con-
